Definition in the 4C Glossary

The CCEx is intended to be an online, virtual community platform for the exchange of curation cost information. The CCEx will be used to gather cost information from partner organisations and stakeholders, submitted to the exchange using a Submission Form/Template. The form will aim to capture calculation processes, metrics, effort statistics, value calculations, from stakeholders in order to underpin future activity with empirical knowledge.

Possibilities?

Recommender service:

System asks user what they are doing, what sorts of data, what sorts of use case for the data:

System feeds back recommendations ... You need to think about headings XYZ, you should look at cost model ABC, you might want to read the following analysis of that tool...

Like a cost model trip advisor?

Possibilities?

The Oracle:

System asks specific financial questions about their process and users upload answers. It gives them an answer in financial terms: the amount of money they will need to preserve a given amount of data.

Like a mortgage calculator?

Possibilities?

Business case generator:

System asks user about the sort of benefits that might accrue from preserving a given data set.

System provides links to case studies of similar examples and generates a report on financial and non-financial benefits for you

Like a KRDS Toolkit online?

Cost model generator:

Presents reference model and interrogates users about their own cost centres and structures

Enables user to generate their own cost model

Like an online tutorial in cost modelling
